The Humboldt Arts Council is pleased to announce a call for entries for the 20th Annual Images of Water Photography Competition and Exhibition. For the first time the *Images of Water* exhibition will be held at the Morris Graves Museum of Art. Celebrating creative visions of water, this annual competition is open to all photographers. \$8 per print for HAC members, \$10 per print for non-members. Total size including frame no larger than 2 x 3 feet. Limit 3 entries per artist. All techniques are accepted. Entries will be accepted at the Morris Graves Museum of Art Tuesday, September 26, from 4-6 p.m. There are no demographic restrictions for entering the competition. Photographs previously exhibited in the show will not be accepted. Awards are \$300 for Best of Show; \$150 for 1st Place; \$100 for 2nd; \$50 for 3rd. An Award Reception will be held Arts Alive, Saturday, October 7th at 7 p.m. Please review detailed entry guidelines available at the Museum or at www.humboldtarts.org.

This year's juror is Diana Schoenfeld. Diana Schoenfeld has a master's degree in studio art/photography and a master's of fine art in the history and practice of photography from the University of New Mexico, and has taught classes at College of the Redwoods and Humboldt State University. She was awarded the Grand Prize in the Humboldt Arts Council's 5th Annual Northwest Eye Photography Competition in 2006. For the past 12 years, Schoenfeld has been involved in an intensive documentary study of old, abandoned schoolhouses throughout the United States.

The Morris Graves Museum of Art, located at 636 F Street, Eureka is open to the public noon-5p.m., Wednesday through Sunday. Museum admission is by donation: \$4 for adults, \$1 for seniors age 55 and older; HAC Members and children age 12 and under are admitted free. Admission is always free for everyone during each First Saturday Arts Alive!, 6-9 p.m.
