Calling all artists! The Humboldt Arts Council will be accepting entries for the 12th Annual Junque Arte Competition and Exhibition Friday, September 29th from noon to 6 p.m. The exhibition will run from October 7 to December 3 in the William Thonson Gallery. An opening reception will be held October 7, from 6 to 9 p.m. during *First Saturday Night Arts Alive!*

To be eligible, art works must be made of 100% recycled materials. Please review detailed entry guidelines available at the Museum or at www.humboldtarts.org. Adult, youth, and Group submissions will be accepted, and awards are given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place within each category as well as a Best of Show Award. Awards will be presented to this year's winners October 7th at 7 p.m., during the *First Saturday Night Arts Alive!* opening reception. The public is invited to attend.

This year's juror is Charlotte Kruk n' Kempken. Best known for her "wearable sculptures" created from meticulously unwrapped, consumed and conscientiously collated consumer product packaging. Each element of "trash" is carefully stitched together side by side to create new textiles, these sculptures are a direct commentary on the gluttony and wastefulness of a disposable, packaged society. Her work has been exhibited at Copia in Napa, The Kohler Arts Center in Wisconsin and the Legion of Honor in San Francisco.

The Morris Graves Museum of Art, located at 636 F Street, Eureka is open to the public noon-5p.m., Wednesday through Sunday. Museum admission is by donation: \$4 for adults, \$1 for seniors age 55 and older; HAC Members and children age 12 and under are admitted free. Admission is always free for everyone during each First Saturday Arts Alive!, 6-9 p.m.
