Michelle Rogers Le Temps Retrouvé/Revisiting the Past

The Humboldt Arts Council is pleased to announce the opening of the exhibition ***Michelle Rogers Le Temps Retrouvé/Revisiting the Past*** in the Tom Knight Gallery at the Morris Graves Museum of Art.

A selection of "collages" of old postcards juxtaposed with the artist's own images brings out new visual relationships between different times and places and implies an enigmatic narrative. These triptychs allow the artist to bridge the gap between the past and present, and forge a new link with the earlier, often anonymous postcard photographer. A number of the photographs feature a man in a bowler hat, always seen from the back. This figure, devoid of identity, gender, age, or social status brings a human presence into this surrealistic world.

The Morris Graves Museum of Art, located at 636 F Street, Eureka is open to the public noon-5p.m., Thursday through Sunday. Museum admission is by donation: \$4 for adults, \$1 for seniors age 55 and older; HAC Members and children age 12 and under are admitted free. Admission is always free for everyone during each First Saturday Arts Alive!, 6-9 p.m.
