The Humboldt Arts Council in the Morris Graves Museum of Art is honored to highlight a large body of iron works by artist Frederick Hazard in the Melvin Schuler Sculpture Garden. Beyond traditional "junk art", Hazard's sculptures emphasize classical forms while employing found objects such as machine parts, tools and utilitarian items. The rustic patina highlights the many sculptural elements included in each work, yet focuses on the sculptural combination as a whole. The complicated and formal presentation of each work encompasses movement within each individual piece and the installation.

The Morris Graves Museum of Art, located at 636 F Street, Eureka is open to the public noon-5p.m., Wednesday through Sunday. Museum admission is by donation: \$4 for adults, \$1 for seniors age 55 and older; HAC Members and children age 12 and under are admitted free. Admission is always free for everyone during each First Saturday Arts Alive!, 6-9 p.m.
