The Humboldt Arts Council is pleased to announce a call for entries for the 6th Annual Northwest Eye Regional Fine Art Photography Competition & Exhibition in the Morris Graves Museum of Art. Open to all photographers residing in the Pacific Northwest: Northern California (from Monterey Bay north), Oregon, Washington, British Columbia, Yukon Territory, and Alaska. Five Best of Show Awards for \$250 each and a Grand Prize Award of \$1000.

This year's juror is Brad Cole. Cole's imagery escapes time and appearances in order to delve beneath surface experience into deeper levels of dream and myth. Primarily using an early-1900s 5"x7" view camera, Cole hand-crafts silver-based prints of exquisitely rich and seductive tonalities. This discipline also informs the base for his films, slide-dissolve/sound projects, as well as other works. The Last Dream, Cole's 50 plate monograph with an essay by A.D. Coleman, is published by the Center for Photographic Art, Carmel, CA. In 2001, Cole was named Artist of the Year by the Center for Photographic Art. Cole will be giving a juror presentation on Friday, February 9th at 6 p.m. at the Museum.

Call for entry forms can be picked up at the Morris Graves Museum of Art during open hours, Wednesday through Sunday noon to 5 p.m. or by visiting www.humboldtarts.org. The entry deadline is Tuesday, February 6, 3 to 6 p.m. at the Morris Graves Museum of Art.

The Morris Graves Museum of Art, located at 636 F Street, Eureka is open to the public noon-5p.m., Wednesday through Sunday. Museum admission is by donation: \$4 for adults, \$1 for seniors age 55 and older; HAC Members and children age 12 and under are admitted free.
