Since 2005 the Humboldt Arts Council has received a selection of beautiful gifts to the Permanent Collection. Through May 13 these recent acquisitions are highlighted in an exhibition in the Anderson Gallery. On exhibit are three sculptures by Bruno Groth, two large-scale paintings by Glenn Berry, and an original lithograph by David Hockney. A variety of other works are on view including a striking oil painting of *Bunker, Samoa* by Ingrid Nickelsen.

As part of the "Adopt a Masterpiece" campaign, a variety of works will be on display that have been adopted by members of our community for support of the conservation and documentation of the collection and individual artworks.
