## March 3, 2007- Hearthfire

Join the Humboldt Arts Council and the Morris Graves Museum of Art for First Saturday Arts Alive! featuring Heartfire. Harp duo **Hearthfire** creates an eclectic Celtic-pop-world music sound with harp, guitar, cittern, mandol, bass, and vocals. Their repertoire includes original vocal and instrumental tunes plus traditional pieces from Ireland, Scotland, England, and North Africa. Their uplifting songs touch the heart in a soulful blend of visionary pop, new age, world fusion, and folk rock. One of the unique features of their sound is the combination of the bell-like ringing tones of the wire-strung harp with the sweet, mellow tones of the nylon-strung harp. Featured during the concert will be the Electrolyre™ ([www.electrolyre.com](http://www.electrolyre.com)), a one-of-a-kind cross between a harp and an electric guitar.

### About the Musicians...

Multi-instrumentalists, composers, and singer/songwriters Lynne Reardon and Michael Koster have been performing together for 13 years. Their experience includes festivals, concerts, coffee houses, private events, and Scottish Highland Games. They were also part of the Bread & Roses ([www.breadandroses.org](http://www.breadandroses.org)) lineup of entertainers until their recent move from the Bay Area. Michael and Lynne are owners of Redwood Coast Music, which sells custom-built instruments and pro audio gear, offers harp instruction, and provides music recording services in Eureka.
