The music he will share is stylistically rooted in the 1950's West Coast or Cool Jazz genre, and will include some originals as well as choice compositions gleaned from jazz standards and Bossa Nova. The band will be comprised of local standouts Lukas Hein -tenor saxophone, Shao Way Wu - Bass, Dave Wilson -Guitar, and Pablo Rotter –Drums.
